

Oil and Gas Lease!

Agreement made and entered into the 4th day of May A.D. 1907
 between Thelma Robinson and S.S. Robinson of Tulsa
 Okla. parties of the first part and C. B. Robinson, Leamie Young
 Jr., Thurman Mathew L. Young, John C. Mitchell, parties
 of the second part.

Witnesseth That the said party of the first part for
 in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred Dollars in
 land well and truly paid by the said party of the second
 part, the receipt of which is hereto acknowledged and of the
 covenants and agreements herein after contained on the part
 of the said party of the second part to be paid, kept and per-
 formed, hereto given, demise, lease and let unto the said
 part of the second part, their heirs or assigns for the sole
 and only purpose of mining and operating for oil and gas
 and of laying pipe lines, steam, water, gas and shaft holes
 to and from adjoining land and of building tanks,
 stations and structures thereon to take care of said products
 with the right of going in upon, over and across said land
 for the purpose of operating the same, also with the right
 to subdivide and release the same or any part thereof
 all of the following described tract of land situated in the
 Cherokee Nation and within the Indian Territory to-wit:
 N.W. 1/4 of S.W. 1/4 and N.W. 1/4 of T.E. 1/4 of S.W. 1/4 of Section 10,
 Range 13, Township 21, 2 Section — of Township — North of
 Range — East of the Indian Meridian and containing
 fifty acres more or less.

It is agreed That this lease shall remain in force
 for the term of fifteen years from this date and as long
 thereafter as oil or gas or either of them is produced there-
 from by the party of the second part, their heirs or assigns
 In Consideration of the Premises That said party of the
 second part covenant and agree: 1st. — To deliver to the credit
