

Oil and Gas Lease

Agreement made and entered into on the 13th day of January A.D., 1908 between Cooley Vann of Caloosa Okla county & and a party of the first part and Cushing Oil and Gas Co., party of the second party witnesseth that the said party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of Forty Dollars to him in hand well and truly paid by the said party of the second part the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged and of the covenants and agreements hereinafter contained on the part of the said party of the second part to be paid kept and performed has granted, demised leased and let and by these presents do grant demise lease and let unto the said party of the second part its heirs executors administrators or assigns for the sole and only purpose of mining and operating for oil and gas and of laying pipe lines and of building tanks stations and structures thereon to take care of said premises all that certain tract of land situated in Tulsa County Oklahoma to wit:-

T 20 R. 14, allotted to Cooley Vann except his homestead containing 40 acres, total acreage leased - and being the same land conveyed to the first party by Cherokee Nation by deed bearing date & reserving
