

AND WHEREAS, the said Bolton Oil & Gas Company did drill a well for oil or gas during the early summer of the year 1921, stopping said well at a depth of 1500 feet and coming back and shooting the sand found at 1010 to 1030 feet in which a good show of oil was found but which failed to produce. AND WHEREAS, the said Bolton Oil & Gas Company had moved tools in over said well for the purpose of drilling on down to the deep sand found at about 2100 feet, before the expiration of the said three year term of said leases. NOW THEREFORE, This is to acknowledge the fact that the said Bolton Oil & Gas Company are acting within their rights in completing the said well on down to the deep sand above mentioned, and to grant our extension of the terms of said leases for the time required for drilling said well on down to the deep sand, and in event that oil or gas should be produced in paying quantities from this deeper drilling of said well to acknowledge the validity of the title of said Bolton Oil & Gas Company for the term as long thereafter as oil or gas was found on the premises developed or operated.
