205111 LB COMPARED QUIT CLAIM DEED

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 19th day of July A. D., 1922. between S. R. Travis, of the first part, and Lydia J. Sheppard of the second part. WITNESSETH, That said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One DOLLARS to him duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged has quit claimed, granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents does for himself, his heirs, executors and administrators, quit claim, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns, forever, all his right, title, interest, estate claim and demand both at law and equity in and to all the following described property, to-wit:

All of Lot One, and the North 30 feet of Lot Two, in Block Seven, of Aaronson's Sub Division of Block Seven, Buena Vista Park Addition to the city of Tulsa, according to the recorded plat thereof.

The above described property has never been claimed or occupied by the grantor as a Homestead. This deed is made to convey and Quit Claim any interest grantor may have by reason of a pending suit entitled S. R. Travis, VS L. E. Z. Aaronson, et al., Case No. 19279. Together with all and singular hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above described premises unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, so that neither the said party of the first part or any person in his name and behalf, shall or will hereafter claim or demand any right or title to the said premises or any part thereof; but they and every one of them shall be these presents be excluded and forever barred.
