

PETITION FOR APPROVAL OF FULL-BLOOD DEED TO INHERITED LANDS

Comes now Sammie Naharkey, petitioner herein, and shows to the court that he is the son of Moses Naharkey, a deceased full-blood citizen of the Creek Nation, Roll No. 4363, who departed this life on or about the ---day of-----, 1905, leaving petitioner, Millie Naharkey, and Martha Naharkey as his sole and only heirs at law, petitioner being also a full-blood citizen of the Creek Nation, Roll No. 4365, and who inherited an undivided one-half interest in the allotment of the said Moses Naharkey; that the said Moses Naharkey, at the time of his death, was about forty-seven years of age, and died intestate; that the said Moses Naharkey, at the time of his death, was a resident of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, living near Redfork, in said County, and state,

That the said Moses Naharkey, at the time of his death, was seized and possessed of an allotment of land which had theretofore been granted to him as his proportionate share of the lands of the Creek Nation, or Tribe of Indians, said allotment lying within the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, and being particularly described as follows:

W2 of NE4 of Sec. 35; W2 of W2 of SE4 of 26, all in T. 19 N., R. 12 E.;

and Ne4 of SE4 of Sec. 15, T. 19N., R. 13E.,

and that upon the death of Moses Naharkey the title to the said lands vested in your petitioner as to an undivided one-half interest.

Your petitioner further show that that he has, this day, made, executed, and delivered to Frank L. Townsend Warranty deed conveying all his right, title and interest in and to that portion of said allotment of Moses Naharkey deceased; described as follows in so far as said deed is concerned:

W2 of NE4 of Sec 35, T. 19N., R. 12 E.,

the consideration for said warranty deed to the said Frank L. Townsend being the sum of One Thousand and no/100 Dollars as purchase price for said land; that the said sum of One Thousand and no/100 Dollars is a fair and adequate consideration for said lands and that your petitioner are desirous that the Court approve the sale of said lands under the power vested in the Court by Act of Congress of May 27, 1908, and by Chapter 198 of the Session Laws of Oklahoma of 1915.

WHEREFORE, petitioner pray that the Court approve and confirm the said deed to the said Frank L. Townsend.
