205552 LB COMPARED AFFIDAVIT

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN: "STATE OF OKLAHOMA, COUNTY OF TULSA, SS. Jessie A. Brown, of lawful age being first duly sworn on oath states: That on the 29th day of November, 1916, she was the owner of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 32, Township 20 North, Range 13 East in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, containing forty (40) acres, more or less, according to the Government Survey thereof; that on said date she caused said property to be surveyed and platted by R. K. Hughes, County Surveyor, and the Certificate of R. K. Hughes, County Surveyor, and a plat of said property was filed in the office of the County Clerk within and for Tulsa County, Oklahoma, Jan'y 22-1917 said sub-division being named Garden Acres.

Affiant further states that on the 6th day of December, 1916, she dedicated to the public all of the streets in said Garden Acres for public use so long as same were used for streets, said deed of dedication being filed in the Office of the County Clerk of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, on the 22nd day of January, 1917, that through inadvertence and mistake the name "Brown's Sub-division of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 32, Township 20 North, Range 13 East in Tulsa County, Oklahoma," was used instead of "Garden Acres "Sub-division of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 32, Township 20 North, Range 13 East in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, " and that affiant, on the 3rd day of July, 1922, re-dedicated to the public the streets in Garden Acres Sub-division and that said last named dedication was made for the purpose of correcting the error made when same was dedicated on the 6th day of December, 1916.

Affiant further states that said property above described is not now and never has been used as her homestead; that J. H. Brown, who signed the deed of dedication dated the 6th day of December, 1916, was the husband of this affiant and that said J. H. Brown died on the 5th day of April, 1921. and that he never had any interest in the property
