BE IT KNOWN, That the undersigned citizens of the State of Oklahoma, do hereby voluntarily associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a private Corporation under the laws of the State of Oklahoma, and do hereby certify, FIRST: That the name of this Corporation shall be South Side Investment Company, SECOND: That the purpose for which this Corporation is formed is to own buy and sell Real Estate of all kinds, to buy Build and Sell Business Houses, Warehouses and Dwellings Houses, Apartment Houses, Hotels, and Garages, To Rent and lease Buiness Houses, Warehouses, Dweling and Apartment Houses, Hotels and Garages. To make loans and mortgages in Real estate. To Plan Subdivide and lay out additions, c, THIRD: That the places where its principal business is to be transacted is at 901 South Boston, Tulsa Oklahoma. FOURTH: That the term for which the Corporation is to exist is Twenty years. FIFTH: The number of Directors or Trustees of this Corporation and the names and residences of such of them who are to serve until the election of such officers and their qualifications.
