205700 LB #200 ASSIGNMENT OF OIL AND GAS LEASE
 WHEREAS, The Secretary of the Interior has heretofore approved an oil and gas mining lease, dated January 24th 1920, entered into by and between Waite Phillips, lessee, and Joel Fields, of Muskogee, Oklahoma, lessor, covering the following described lands in the Cherokee Nation, Oklahoma:

The Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 23, Twp. 22N., R. 13 E. (containing 40 acres, more or less.)

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of One Dollar and other good and valuable consideration (\$1.00) dollars the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said Waite Phillips, the lessee in the above-described lease, hereby bargains, sells, transfers, assigns, and conveys an undivided 1/4 interest of his right, title, and interest of the lessee in and to said lease, subject to the approval of the Secretary of the Interior to Phillips Hawkeye Drilling Company, of Tulsa, Okla. (Said assignment to be effective from date of approval hereof by the Secretary of the Interior.)
