205701 LB #242 ASSIGNMENT OF OIL AND GAS LEASE

WHEREAS, The Secretary of the Interior has heretofore approved an oil and gas mining lease, dated March 4th 1920,

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of One Dollar and other good and valuable consideration (\$1.00) dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said Waite Phillips, the lessee in the above-described lease, hereby bargains, sells, transfers, assigns, and conveys an undivided 1/4 interest of his right, title, and interest of the lessee in and to said lease, subject to the approval of the Secretary of the Interior to Phillips Hawkeye Drilling Co. of Tulsa, Okla. Said assignment to be effective from date of approval hereof by the Secretary of the Interior.
