AFFIDAVIT

STATE OF OKLAHOMA )

SS. Comes now, on this 28th day of July 1922, before me the undersigned, a Notary Public in and for said County and State, one George W. Smiley, of Lawful age, who being duly sworn, deposes and says:

That patent from The Cherokee Nation was issued to him under date of January 15th, 1907 covering;

The South Twenty (22) Two feet of Lot four (4) All of Lot Five (5) (with other property not in Question) all in Block Eleven (11), in the town of North Tulsa, Indian Territory, according to the plat approved April 16, 1904 .

And, that under date of December 6th, 1904, he as G. W. Smiley together with M. C. Smiley, his wife, did <sup>make</sup> ~~same~~ and execute a Warranty Deed in favor of Myra Warfield Covering:-

The north twenty two (22) feet of lot four (4), and all of lot five (5), and the north fifteen (15) feet of lot six (6), and the north 15 feet of Lot fourteen (14) and the south one hundred twenty-two (122) feet of Lot 15, all in block eleven (11) according to Government survey and plat of North Tulsa, Indian Territory, approved by the Secretary of the Interior.

Said Warranty Deed having been recorded in the office of the U. S. Clerk and Ex-officio Recorder at Sapulpa, I. T., in book 4 page 257. This deed was in error in referring to the North 22 feet of lot 4 and should have read the South 22 feet of Lot 4; and in order to correct the mis-discription just mentioned, and to identify George W. Smiley and G. W. Smiley as being one and the same person, the said George W. Smiley and Mary C. Smiley, his wife, did under date of May 11th, 1905, make and execute another Warranty Deed to Myra Warfield, reading as follows:-

South Twenty two (22) feet of Lot four (4) all of lot five (5) North fifteen (15) feet of Lot six (6), and part of lot fourteen (14), described as follows; Beginning at the northwest corner of lot fourteen (14) in block eleven (11), thence running northeasterly along line between lots fourteen (14) and fifteen (15) 136.7 feet, thence southeasterly along line between lots six and fourteen (6 & 14) fifteen (15) feet, thence southwesterly parallel to and 85 feet distant from line between lots 13 and 14, to block Ten (10); thence north along block line to the place of beginning; Part of lot 15, block 11, described to-wit: Beginning at the southwest corner of lot 15 in block 11, thence running northeasterly along line between lots 14 and 15, 136.7 feet, thence northwesterly along line between lots 14 and 5 and lot 15, 122 feet; thence southwesterly parallel to and 122 feet distant from line between lots 14 and 15 to block line, thence south along said block line to place of beginning,
