

second parties, and that as a consideration for said assignment and drilling said well, said second parties are to furnish the necessary amount of gas for fuel to drill said well to the Wilcox sand unless oil or gas is found in paying quantities at a lesser depth.

4. It is further agreed that if said well should be a dry hole, said first party is to retain all casing and other material used in the drilling of the same.

5. It is further agreed by and between the parties hereto that if said well should produce oil or gas in paying quantities, then the parties hereto are to furnish the expense for the operation and all future development of said lease in proportion to their interests herein.

This contract is made in duplicate and is binding upon the parties hereto, their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns.
