

production, the interest herein conveyed being an undivided seven sixty-fourths (7/64) of the oil thereafter produced on said lease.

7. THAT party of second part has sold and assigned, and by these presents does hereby sell and assign to party of first part seven eighths (7/8) of his right, title, and interest in and to the lease and leasehold estate herein described, his interest in said lease and leasehold estate being the working interest in the gas and gas mining rights under said lease; and the party of second part has also sold and conveyed and by these presents does hereby sell and convey to party of first part one-half of the gas royalty reserved under the aforesaid lease, together with one-half of the oil and gas mining rights in and to the premises covered by said lease, the interest hereunder conveyed being further described as seven-eighths (7/8) of the gas hereafter run on account of the working interest under the aforesaid lease, and one-half of the gas run hereafter on account of the royalty interest under the aforesaid lease, together with the right to collect one-half of all rentals and royalties otherwise paid, with the right to hold an undivided half-interest in and to the gas and gas mining rights after the expiration of the aforesaid lease.

8. THAT it is agreed that if any part of the title of either party to the property herein exchanged should fail, then this instrument shall be and become null and void and the respective rights herein exchanged shall revert to the parties herein granting the same.
