Jas. M. Wolford of Iola, Kansas and J. C. Neal, E. E. O'Brien, C. E. Kahle, John A. Uder of Drumright, Oklahoma, hereby transfers, makes over, assigns, deeds and conveys to Jas. M. Wolford as trustee all his interest in an oil lease covering the 40 acre oil & gas lease Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 11, Township 34 North, Range 18 East I. M. Allen County, Kansas, and the South one-half (S $\frac{1}{2}$) of Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) with Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) with Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) Section 35, Township 18 North, Range 7 East, I. M. in Creek County, Oklahoma, being an undivided complete interest in the same.

And said Jas. M. Wolford as trustee hereby accepts said transfer, assignment, conveyance and deed in trust upon the following terms, to-wit:

Hereby a trust is created under the terms of Chapter sixteen Session Laws of 1919 of the State of Oklahoma entitled "An Act supplemental to and amendatory of Article IV, Chapter 65, Revised Laws of Oklahoma, 1910, etc." Said trust estate shall be known as "K-O-TEX OIL Co." and its principal business shall be conducted at its office at number 708 Daniel Bldg., Tulsa, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, or such other place or places as the trustees shall by resolution determine, for the term of 21 years unless sooner wound up hereunder.

Said trustee, or the majority of the trustees jointly if any other one or more are added hereunder, shall have power to conduct a business in said name anywhere in the State of Oklahoma or the United States either as owner, lessee, agent or manager or any well or wells producing oil or gas or either; of carrying or transporting crude oil or petroleum or natural gas, or any of the products of either or both, by or through pipe lines, tank cars, trucks or wagons, for hire or otherwise; of refining or manufacturing any of the products of either petroleum or natural gas either for hire or otherwise; of storing
