THIS INDENTURE, made this first day of August A. D. 1922 between Eliza M. Wright, and G. N. Wright, her husband, of Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma parties of the first part, and Nora Vanderslice, and Nora Vanderslice as Guardian of Elenor Vanderslice,

a minor parties of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of FIFTY THOUSAND (\$50,000.00) DOLLARS the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said parties of the second part their heirs, successors and assigns, all the following described real estate, situated in Tulsa County and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The North Thirty-two (32) feet of Lot Five, and all of Lot Six (6) in Block Twenty-Eight (28) of the Original Town, now City, of Tulsa, according to the Official Plat thereof.

The loan secured by this mortgage represents the unpaid balance due on a loan made August 9, 1918, by E. M. Vanderslice (now deceased) to G. N. Wright, evidenced by one promissory note for \$53,800.00 dated August 9, 1918, signed by G. N. Wright and payable to E. M.
