make and maintain such insurance and pay such taxes and assessments then these presents shall be wholly discharged and void, otherwise shall remain in full force and effect.

If said insurance is not effected and maintained, or if any and all taxes and assessments which are or may be levided and assessed lawfully against said premises, or any part thereof, are not paid before delinquent, then the mortgage may effect such insurance or pay such taxes and assessments and shall be allowed interest, thereon at the rate of Ten per cent per annum, until paid, and this mortgage shall stand as security for all such payments; and if said sums of money or any part thereof is not paid when due, of if such insurance is not effected and maintained or any taxes or assessments are not paid before delinquent, the holder of said note----and this mortgage may elect to declare the whole sum or sums and interest thereon due and payable at once and proceed to collect said debt including attorneys fees, and to foreclose this mortgage, and shall become entitled to possession of said premises.

Said first party waive all notice of election to declare the whole debt due as above and also the benefit of stay, valuation or appraisement laws.

HORNE, of West Iblip, New York, (hereinafter commonly referred to as the Co-Trustee, said Corporate Trustee and Co-Trustee being hereinafter together commonly referred to as Trustee).

WITNESSETH:
