

to the said Frederick J. Horne.

SECTION 2. In case the said Frederick J. Horne, or any successor to him as Co-Trustee, shall die, become incapable of acting, resign, or be removed, all the estate, properties, rights, powers, trusts, duties and obligations of the Trustees hereunder so far as permitted by law shall vest in and <sup>be</sup> exercised by said The New York Trust Company, or its successors as Corporate Trustee, until the appointment of a new Co-Trustee, as hereinbefore provided.

ARTICLE SIXTEEN .

If any provision of this mortgage shall be held or deemed, as applied in any particular case, to be inoperative or unenforceable in any jurisdiction, or jurisdictions, because conflicting with any provisions of any constitution or statute or any rule of public policy or for any other reason, such provision shall not for that reason be held or deemed inoperative or unenforceable in any other case, and if any provision or provisions hereof be in fact inoperative or unenforceable in any given case or cases in any jurisdiction or jurisdictions, such circumstances shall not have the effect of rendering the provision in question inoperative or unenforceable in any other case or of rendering any other provision or provisions herein contained invalid, inoperative or unenforceable to any extent whatever.

This mortgage is simultaneously executed in four counterparts, each of which so executed shall be deemed to be the original though all or any of the others may not be produced, and such counterparts shall constitute one and the same instrument.

At the time of the execution and delivery hereof \$2,500,000 is the principal amount of indebtedness secured by this mortgage.
