

the event of default of payment by lessor, and be subrogated to the rights of the holder thereof.

It is further agreed by the lessee that a well shall be commenced within three months from the date of this lease on the West half of the Southeast quarter of Section 9, Township 21, Range 13, within about 200 feet, more or less, of the south line of the tract owned by lessor and described above, which shall be, if oil is found in paying quantities, offset by a well a similar distance north of lessor's south line, to be commenced within sixty days or less of the date of completion of first described well, or this lease becomes null and void.
