KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That A. W. McDowell and Rozell McDowell, his wife of Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, parties of the first part, have mortgaged and hereby mortgage to Title Guarantee & Trust Company of Tulsa, Oklahoma party of the second part the following described real estate and premises, situate in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit: A strip of land beginning at the Southeast Corner of Section fourteen (14) Township Eighteen (18) North, Range Thirteen (13) East running thence West a distance of Fifty-six and six-tenths (56.6) rods thence North parallel with the East line of said section a distance of fifty-six and six-tenths (56.6) rods, thence East parallel with the South line of said Section, a distance of fifty six and six-tenths (56.6) rods, thence South along the East line of said Section, a distance of fifty-six and six-tenths (56.6) rods to the place of beginning, all in Section Fourteen (14), Township Eighteen (18) North, Range Thirteen (13) East, containing in all Twenty (20) acres, more or less with all the improvements thereon and appurtenances thereunto belonging, and warrant the title to the same.

This Mortgage is given to secure the principal sum of Fifteen Hundred & No/100 Dollars, with interest thereon at the rate of 8 per cent per annum, payable semi annually from July 26, 1922 according to the terms of one certain promissory note, described as follows, to-wit:

One note in the sum of Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1500.00), dated July 26th, 1922 and due July 26, 1924, executed by A. W.
