WITNESSETH, That said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Eight Hundred & No/100 DOLLARS, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said party of the second part her heir and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lots 1,2,3, and 4, in Block 9, Town of Glenpool, County of Tulsa
State of Oklahoma.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or any wise appertaining forever.

And said A. R. Cox and for his heirs, executors or administrators, does hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part that at the delivery of these presents he lawfully seized in his own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance in fee simple, of and in all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear and discharged and unincumbered of and from all former and other grants, titles, charges, estates, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever; and that he will warrant and defend the same unto the said party of the second part her heirs and assigns, against said party of the first part his heirs and assigns, and all and every person or persons whosoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
