O. R. Griggs first being duly sworn states that he is the Olive R. Griggs mentioned in Judgement 3300 in the District Court of Tulsa County Oklahoma, titled Upp Grocer Co vs. Griggs S H & S M Griggs S H and Griggs Olive R. and that he was a member of the above named firm at the time suit was brought and Judgement rendered in favor of the Upp Grocer Company and that at the time they were in business he acted as a clerk in the store and had very little if any management of the business as the same was managed by his father and at the time he was the owner of several lots in the town of Sperry and that attachment was levied on the lots and the same were sold and that he supposed that it liquidated all of the indebtedness as he never heard any thing further regarding the same and inasmuch as it was a copartnership it was necessary for it to be settled in this way as the other members of the firm had no other property and that he could have saved the real estate sold to liquidate the indebtedness as the same was a homestead but that he was willing for the same to sell in order that the creditors might be satisfied.

Affiant further states that as he had little or nothing to do with the management of the business that he should not be morally held for the success or failure of the business and that it was his intention that the debts be paid and supposed that they were.
