LETTERS OF GUARDIANSHIP

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME GREETING:

Know Ye, That whereas Moses T. Jefferson has on this day by the United States Court in Probate, in and for the said Western District of the Indian Territory, has been appointed, Guardian for Thomas Jefferson, minor, under the age of fourteen years, by his entering into bond to the United States of America, for the use of said minor, in the sum of Six Hundred Dollars; and whereas the said Moses T. Jefferson has this day filed his bond in such sum to the United States of America, for the use of said minor, which said bond stands approved by the Court.

NOW THEREFORE, he the said Moses T. Jefferson is hereby authorized and empowered to collect and receive all moneys, property and effect that now are, or hereafter may become due to his said ward, and in general to do and perform all and singular the duties devolving upon him as such Guardian by law, or that may be enjoined upon him by the lawful order, sentence or decree of any court having competent jurisdiction.
