GUAHDIAN'S DEED.

THIS INDENTURE, made the -----day of August, 1922 by and between David sanders of Owasso, Okla, the duly appointed, qualified and acting guardian of the estate of Jesse J. Sanders, a minor, party of the first part, and Chas. A. Settle, party of the second part.
