204572 C.J. **COMPARED** ASSIGNMENT OF OIL AND GAS LEASE.

Whereas, On the 9th day of March, 1921, a certain oil and gas mining lease was made and entered into by and between John J. Donahoe and Mrs. E. L. Donahoe, Lessors, and Frank Sparks, Lessee, covering the following described land in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The Northwest acre of the Northwest quarter of Section Seventeen, in township Seventeen, North, of Range Thirteen, east.

Said lease being recorded in the office of the County Clerk of said County in Book at page and,

Whereas, On the 17th day of April, 1913, E. L. DONAHOE and J. J. Donahoe and J. L. Donahoe, made executed and delivered to A. H. Black, J. A. Sivals, E. F. Black and W. G. Bryson a certain oil and gas mining lease covering the following described property in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The North half of the Northwest quarter and the Southeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section Seventeen, Township Seventeen, north, Range Thirteen, east, less one acre in the Northwest corner reserved for school purposes, containing 119 acres more or less.

Woodard, trustee, his successors and assigns, an undivided Five-Sixteenths interest and title in and to said original leases and rights thereunder in so far as they cover the land last above described.

And for the same consideration the said Brooklyn Oil and gas Company does hereby covenant with the said John R. Woodard, Trustee, that it is lawfully seized of the interest and title hereby conveyed and that it has good right and lawful authority to sell and convey the same, that the said rights and interests are free and clear of all liens
