AGREEMENT OR DECLARATION OF TRUST OF
TURKEY MOUNTAIN OIL COMPANY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That whereas, the subscriber, Phil W. Davis, Jr., of Tulsa, Oklahoma, desires to establish a common law trust for the purpose of conducting an oil and gas business under this Declaration of Trust, and

Whereas, the said subscriber proposes that said trust shall acquire and develop oil and gas properties, one of which is hereinafter more specifically described, and

Whereas, the said subscriber is a party to a certain contract with the owner thereof for the sale of an interest in an oil and gas mining lease on the following described property to-wit:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 35, Township 19 North, Range 12 East, in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma. and has the right to purchase said interest upon the terms in said contract and,

Whereas, said contract and the rights of the subscriber therein are assignable by the provisions of said contract.

Now therefore:

1. A common law trust hereby is constituted by this Declaration of Trust, the name of which shall be TURKEY MOUNTAIN OIL COMPANY.

2. All business conducted under this Declaration of Trust and all contracts or documents executed in pursuance of the objects of this Trust shall be as far as possible in the name of Turkey Mountain Oil Company.

3. The principal place of business of said trust shall be 329 Mayo Building, Tulsa, Oklahoma, and such other place or places as the trustees may hereinafter designate.

4. This Trust shall continue for a period of twenty-one years unless dissolved in the manner hereinafter set forth.

5. The purchasers of beneficial interests in this Trust shall be known as shareholders therein.
