208267 GH COMPARED PARTIAL RELEASE OF RESTRICTIONS.

This Indenture, made and entered into this 24th day of August 1922, by and
between Woodson E. Norvell and Norma L. Norvell, his wife, parties of the First part,
and Lucile Norvell, party of the second part.

WITNESSETH: That for and in consideration of the sum of One dollar (\$1.00) to us in
hand paid by the second party, we the first parties, ourselves, our heirs, and assigns,
do hereby release and remove the restrictions upon use and alienation of Lots One (1)
Two (2) Three (3) and Four (4) of Block Five (5) in Norvell Park Addition (formerly
Horsley Hill Addition) to the city of Tulsa Tulsa County, Oklahoma, as contained in a
General Warranty deed made, executed acknowledged and delivered by first parties to
second party on October 14th 1921, and recorded in the office of the County Clerk for
Tulsa County, Oklahoma in Book 259, at page 61; except that the restrictions in said
deed against the sale, conveyance, lease or rental of said real estate to any person
of African descent shall remain in force as provided in said deed.

This release shall inure to the benefit of the second party, her heirs and assigns
forever.
