But if said sum or sums of money, or any part thereof, or any interest thereon, is not paid, when the same is due, and if the taxes and assessments of every nature, which are or may be assessed and levied against said premises or any part thereof, are not paid when the same are by law made due and payable, then the whole of said sum or sums and interest thereon shall and by these presents become due and payable, and said party of the second part shall be entitled to the possession of said premises. And the said party of the first part for said consideration does hereby expressly waive an appraisement of said real estate and all benefits of the homestead exemption and stay laws of the State of Oklahoma.

WHEREAS ANNIE Gooden Now Fabala a citizen of the Creek Nation, was allotted the following described land, to-wit:

South Half (S/2) of North <sup>half</sup> (N/2) of Northwest  
Quarter (NW/4) of North East Quarter of Southwest  
Quarter (SW/4) less Forty-six hundredths (0.46)  
of an acre of Section Four (4) Township Nineteen  
(19) North, Range Ten (10) East of the Indian  
Base and Meridian containing 2.04 acres more or  
less located in Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

Now, Therefore, I under the authority vested in me by the Act of Congress approved May 27, 1908 (Public No 140) and the regulations prescribed thereunder, hereby remove the restrictions from said described land, such removal of restrictions to become effective only and simultaneously with the execution of the deed by said allottee to the purchaser after said land has been sold in compliance with the directions of the Secretary of
