WITNESSETH: That said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Fifteen Thousand (\$15,000.00) dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged does by these presents grant, bargain sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns all of the following described real estate situated in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

All of Block Ten (10) of the Berry Hart's Re-subdivison
of Blocks Seven (7) and Ten (10) of the Roosevelt Addition
to the city of Tulsa, Oklahoma according to the recorded plat
thereof.

To have and to Hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining forever.
