

Now, Therefore, I, under the authority vested in me by the Act of Congress approved May 27, 1908 Public No 140) and the regulations prescribed thereunder hereby remove the restrictions from said described land such removal of restrictions to become effective only and simultaneously with the execution of the deed by said allottee to the purchaser after said land has been sold in compliance with the directions of the Secretary of the Interior.
