TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, Greeting.

WHEREAS By the Act of Congress Approved July 1, 1902 (32 Stat 716) ratified by
Cherokee Nation August 7, 1902, it is provided that there shall be allotted by the
Commission to the Five Civilized Tribes to each citizen of the Cherokee Tribe, land
equal in value to one hundred and ten acres of the average allottable lands of
the Cherokee Nation, and,
