Sec. 11. In the event a paying well in any of the Shallow sands is encountered in the deep test provided for herein and the parties hereto mutually agree to save same such shallow well shall be at the equal cost of the parties hereto Second parties agree then to skid the rig and drill the deep test as provided for herein and in the event said test is dry, second parties are to retain & own all equipment used in connection with the drilling of said deep test furnished by it.
