SEWER EASEMENT

That the undersigned, the owner of the legal and equitable title to the following described real estate, situated in the City of Tulsa, Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.001) cash in hand paid by the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and other good and valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged less hereby grant and convey unto the said City of Tulsa, Oklahoma a perpetual easement, through, over under and across the following described property, situated in said City to-wit:

A strip of ground not to exceed ten (10) feet in width on either side of the center! line of said sewer line, as shown by the blue prints on file in the City Engineer's office of the City of Tulsa the center line of said Twenty (20) foot strip being more particularly described as follows to-wit:

> Beginning at a point on the North Line of Lot 1. Block 10. Norvell Park Addition to the city of Tulsa. Oklahoma 47 feet East of the Northwest corner of said Lot: thence Southwesterly to a point on the South line of said Lot, 45 feet East of the Southwest corner of said Lot.
