ORDINANCE no. 2322

An Ordinance vacating a portion of Fourteenth Street. A tract of land hereinafter more particularly described as shown in the recorded plat TTT Addition to the city of Tulsa, Oklahoma, with certain reservation and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS a petition signed by all of the property owners owning property abutting on the strip of ground commonly known as a portion of Fourteenth Street T.T.T. Addition to the city of Tulsa, Oklahoma, has been presented to the Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, asking that the strip of ground commonly known as a portion of Fourteenth Street therein described be vacated and abandoned as a public street or alley.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF TULSA OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. That a tract of land 6.5 feet wide described as follows and commonly known as a portion of Fourteenth Street, beginning at the southwest corner of Lot 17, Block 4. TTT addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, thence south along the extension of the West line of said Lot, a distance of 6.5 feet thence East and parallel with the South line of said lot, a distance of 80 feet, thence North and parallel with the West line of said lot, a distance of 6.5 feet to a point on the South line of said lot; thence West along the South line of said lot a distance of 80 feet to the place of beginning.

be and the same is hereby vacated and abandoned as a public street or alley of said City.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, that the city of Tulsa hereby reserves and shall retain forever, the right to construct, reconstruct, repair, maintain and operate sanitary sewers and other appurtenances thereto appertaining now located in said strip of ground, commonly known as a portion of Fourteenth Street, or which of necessity should be constructed or maintained in said strip of ground, commonly known as a portion of
