217837 COMPARET ORDINANCE 43- A.

ORDINANCE ADDING TO THE CITY OF SAND SPRINGS, OKLAHOMA A CERTAIN TRACT OF LAND KNOWN AS OAK RIDGE SECOND ADDITION TO THE CITY. OF SAND SPRINGS. ADDING SAID TERRITORY TO WARD NO 2. AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the real estate and premises known as Oak Ridge Second Addition to the city of Sand Springs, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, according to the recorded plat thereof, and which is more particularly hereinafter described, is lying and situate adjacent to the City limits of the City of Sand Springs, Oklahoma.

WHEREAS, it has been made to appear upon examination by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Sand Springs, State of Oklahoma that the territory hereinbefore mentioned has been subdivided into tracts or parcels of less than five acres, with more than one residence thereon, and is platted into lots and blocks, streets and alleys; the lots for use of residences and other purposes, and the streets dedicated for public, use.

WHEREAS, the BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS of the city of Sand Springs, in its discretion deems proper that said tract of land should be added to the city of Sand Springs Oklahoma.

WHEREAS, a plat and deed of dedication of said real estate has been heretofore made and is now on record in the office of the County Clerk of Tulsa, County Oklahoma.

Now, Therefore, Be It Ordained by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Sand Springs, State of Oklahoma:
