

claims, debts and accounts against said estate have been fully paid and settled and are now allowed by the court and thaisaid estate should now be finally settled and closed and it further appearing that due and proper notice of a final decree, discharge and distribution of the said estate to the parties entitled thereto has been duly given as required by law; and it further appearing from the evidence in open court that said deceased, Royal P. Coup died a citizen and resident of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, intestate and leaving as his sole and only heir at law his wife, Luara I. Coup and that at the time of decedent's death he owned and occupied as his homestead for himself and family an equity in Lot No 6 Block 21 of Owen Addition to the city of Tulsa, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, together with the improvements thereon, which improvements consisted of five room modern fram cottage which was of the approximate value of Five Thousand (\$5000.00) dollars, free and clear of encumbrances; that he also owned a small amount of household and kitchen furniture, and also an undivided one half interest in the furniture fixtures and equipment of a certain barber shop located at 120 East Third Street in the City of Tulsa, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, of the approximate value of One Thousand (\$1000.00) dollars that all of said property, interest or equity in both real and personal property owned by said decedent at the date of his death was acquired and accumulated after marriage to his wife and widow, Laura I. Coup and was owned and acquired by the joint efforts and savings of himself and wife; and that said Laura I Coup is now the sole and only heir of Royal P Coup deceased and as such is entitled to and does inherit the whole of all property left by decedent at his death. It is therefore ordered, adjudged, and decreed by the court that all of the above described real and personal property owned by decedent, Royal P. Coup at the time of his death be and the same is hereby transferred, vested, assigned and conveyed to Laura I. Coup as the sole and only heir at law or in equity of Royal P. Coup deceased, subject however to such, if any, liens as may have existed against the same at the time of decedents death. To have and to hold the same as her exclusive property with all benefits and advantages arising therefrom forever. It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed by the court that Laura I. Coup administratrix of the estate of Royal P. Coup deceased, has fully and faithfully discharged the duties of her trust as such administratrix that she be and is hereby wholly and absolutely discharged from all further duties and responsibility as such administratrix and that the letters of administration formerly issued to her are hereby vacated that said estate is declared fully distributed and her trust settled and closed and the sureties on her bond as such administratrix are hereby released and exonerated from all future liabilities.
