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ORDINANCE NO. 2373

COMPARED An Ordinance vacating an alley, 20 ft. in width in Block One (1) Lake View Addition to the city of Tulsa, Oklahoma said alley being between 13th and 14th Streets and parallel to Troost and Utica Avenues, with certain reservations and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS a petition signed by property owners owning abutting property on the above described alley has been presented to the Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the City of Tulsa Oklahoma, asking that the alley therein described be vacated and abandoned as a public street and alley.

NOW THEREFORE, Be It Ordained BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF TULSA OKLAHOMA.

Section 1. That the alley in Block One (1) Lake View Addition to the city of Tulsa, being between 13th and 14th Streets running North and South and parallel to Troost and Utica Avenues be and the same hereby is vacated and abandoned as a public alley or highway of said City and provided however, that the City of Tulsa, hereby reserves and shall retain forever, the right to construct, reconstruct, repair maintain and operate sanitary sewers, and other appurtenances thereto appertaining now located in said alley, or which of necessity should be constructed or maintained in said alley with the right of ingress and egress over said premises for the purpose above indicated and for said purposes four (4) feet on each side of the center line of said alley is hereby maintained by the City of Tulsa upon which said City of Tulsa may allow public service corporations, companies individuals or itself to construct maintain and operate facilities for public utilities, including, poles wires, pipes conduits and other necessary accessories and,

Provided further, that four (4) feet on each side of the center line of said alley shall be construed to mean sufficient space near the center of said alley for the purposes above specified, and

Provided further, that the above vacation is made subject to and conditional upon
