together with all improvements thereon and appurtenances thereunto belonging; this contract, however, is subject to the following restrictions which constitute the substantial consideration for the execution hereof, and which it is agreed by and between the parties hereto, shall be and remain covenant running with the land and shall be binding upon the said parties of the second part, their heirs, assigns and legal representatives, to-wit:

- (a) Said premises sold for residents' purposes only, and the minimum cost of any dwelling placed thereon, shall be \$4,000.00 when completed, and no part of such dwelling shall be nearer the front line than twenty feet.
- (b) It is expressly understood end agreed that this lot shall never be occupied by or sold to any person of African descent, commonly known as negro, except that the same may be occupied by such negroes only and while employed as a comestic or domestics by any person residing on said premises.

Said Trustie, on behalf of those owning the beneficial interest in said estate at the time of the execution of this deed, as is shown in a certain Trust accesment now of record in the office of the County Clerk, Ex-Officio Register of Deede, of said County and State, dated the 15th day of November, 1919, but not on behalf of the De covenants and agrees with the party of the s cond part that the party of the first part at the time of delivery of these presents is seized of a good and indefeasible title and estate of inheritance in fee simple in and to said real estate and dovere that it isin reaccful and undisputed ressession of said premises, with full right and power to convey the same by this instrument to said party of the second part, and the the same is clear, free and discharged of and from all former and other grants, charge taxes, judgments and other liens or incumbrances of whatsoever kind or nature and hereby binds those having the beneficial interest in said premises, their hours and assigns, forever, to observe the covenants and agreements herein contained and to warrant and defend the title to said land, against all alaims of every nature.
