SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT

State of Okla-

County of Tulsa,

This agreement made and entered into this 2nd day of Aug 1922 By and between T. S. Watts and J. H. Caywood, parties of the first part, and J. A. Shogren and B. McFarlane as parties of the second part,

Witnesseth,

The parties of the first part hereby agrees to waive their requirements in a certain contract executed between the parties of the first and the parties of the second part, on the 14th day of July 1922, relating to the drilling of an oil well on the certain tract or parcel land described as follows, (to wit)

The north half of the north half of the southwest quarter ($N\frac{1}{2}$ of $N\frac{1}{2}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec- (13) Township (18) Range 12E ,

Upon the condition that the parties of the second hereby agrees to install a pump and to pump oil from a certain well that is now on the said tract as described above in lieu of the requirement as set out in the agreement referred to above, said pump is to be installed on the now unused well within the time limit as set out in the original agreement.

This agreement is not to effect the original agreement in any way except as to the parcel or tract of land set out above, in this supplemental agreement.
