DECREE CONFERRING RIGHTS OF MAJORITY:

STATE OF OKLAHOMA,

COMPARED

IN THE DISTRICT COURT IN AND FOR SAID COUNTY AND STATE

IN RE: APPLICATION OR RUBY G. GAULDING? A MINOR; FOR RIGHTS
OF MAJORITY

This matter came on to be heard before me, J. W. Bird, Judge of the District Court in and for the County of Kay, State of Oklahoma, this 6 day of October, 1921, upon the application and petition of Ruby G. Gaulding, a minor, by her next friend, Martha E. Arp, to have the rights of majority conferred upon said Ruby G. Gaulding, a minor, and it appearing to the court that due and legal notice of this application has been given by publication in a newspaper printed in said County and State, and the court having heard the evidence in open court finds that said petitioner is of the age of seventeen years; that she is of sound mind and fully able and competent to transpot her own affairs; that the interests of said petitioner will be materially promoted by granting the prayer of said petition; and that said Ruby G. Gaulding has been an actual resident of this state and of said Kay County in this state for one year next preceding the filing of said petition, and is at present a resident of said Kay County.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the court in pursuance of the authority conferred by Section 4428, Revised Laws of 1910, that the rights of majority concerning contracts be, and the same are hereby conferred upon the said Ruby G. Gaulding, and the said Ruby G. Gaulding is hereby authorized and empowered to transact business in general with the same effect as if such business were transacted by a person over the age of majority, and the said Ruby G. Gaulding is especially authorized and empowered to transfer by good and sufficient title deeds her interest in and to the following described real estate:

Lot Sixteen (16), Block Forty-seven (47), in the City of Collinsville, Tulsa County, Oklahoma;

Lot Four (4), except East ten (10 ft. thereof, in Block Fifteen (15), in the City of Collinsville, Tulsa County, Oklahoma;

Ten (10) feet off the east side of Lot four (4), and the West Half  $(\frac{1}{2})$  of Lot Five (5) in Block Fifteen (15) in the City of Collinsville, Tulsa County. Oklahoma;

East  $^{H}$ alf (  $E_{2}^{h}$ ) of Lot Five (5), Block Fifteen (15) in the City of Collinsville, Tulsa County, Oklahoma;

with the same force and effect as if such title deeds were made, executed, and delivered by a person above the age of twenty-one years.
