REAL ESTATE MORTGAGE EXTENSION

We, the undersigned, do hereby covenant that we are the legal owners of Lot Nine (9) Block Eighteen (18), Gillette Hall Addition to the city of Tulsa, in Tulsa County Oklahoma, the same being the premises conveyed to Isabel H. Loomis by a certain real estate mortgage dated October 2, 1922 made by J. R. Skinner and wife, Raden Skinner which mortgage is recorded in Book 265, page 87 in the Register's of Deeds office in Tulsa County, Oklahoma; said mortgage was given to secure the payment of a certain promissory note for the sum of \$800.00 payable October 2, 1922 such note payable to the order of Isabel H. Loomis, upon which note there remains unpaid the sum of \$800.00 as principal money.

In consideration of the extension of the time for the payment thereof, for the term of Three years from maturity we hereby agree to pay interest on said principal sum as yet unpaid, from the day whereon the same, by the terms of the said note become due, at the rate of 8 per cent per annum, payable semi-annually, for and during said term of extension according to the tenor and effect of the extension coupon notes this day executed.

Coggeshall & Co. in Tulsa, Oklahoma, and in case of default in the payment of any of said extension, or in case of non-payment of taxes or insurance or the breach of any of the covenants contained in the original real estate mortgage, it shall be optional with the holder of said mortgage to declare said principal sum immediately due and payable.
