AGREEMENT, Made and entered into the 9th day of August, 1922, by and between Ina Fitzgerald and James Fitzgerald, her husband of Tulsa, Oklahoma

W. T. Allen & R. W. Linden, Parties of the first part, hereinafter called lessor (whether one or more) and of the second part, hereinafter called lessee.

WITNESSETH, That the said lessor, for and in consideration of One DOLLARS cash in hand paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged and of the covenants and agreements hereinafter contained on the part of lessee to be paid, kept and performed, has granted, demised, leased and let and by these presents does grant, demise lease and let unto the said lessee, for the sole and only purpose of mining and operating for oil and gas, and laying pipe lines, and building tanks, powers, stations and structures thereon to produce, save and take care of said products, all that certain tract of land situate in the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, described as follows, to-wit:

The south one half of the southeast quarter, and the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter of section nine (9) and the north one half of the northeast quarter and the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter of section sixteen (16)

of Section 9-16, Township 19N, Range 14E, and containing 240 acres, more or less

It is agreed that this lease shall remain in force for a term of One (1) years from date, and as long thereafter as oil or gas, or either of them, is produced from said land by the lessee.

In consideration of the premises, the said lessee covenants and agrees: 1st. To deliver to the credit of lessor, free of cost, in the pipe line to which they may connect their wells, the equal one-eighth part of all oil produced and saved from the leased premises.

2nd. To pay the lessor One-eighth of the net proceeds of the gas produced from the premises, and if used in the manufacture of gasoline or any other product, a royalty of one-eighth (1/8) payable monthly at the prevailing market rate.

3rd. To pay lessor for gas produced from any oil well used on the premises, or in the manufacture of gasoline, or any other product, a royalty of one-eighth (1/8) payable monthly at the prevailing market rate.

If no well be commenced on said land on or before the 27th day of August, 1922, this lease shall terminate as to both parties, unless the lessee on or before that date shall pay or tender to the lessor or to the lessor's credit in the bank at Tulsa, Oklahoma, the sum of \$50.00, which shall constitute the consideration for the lease.

If the sum of \$50.00 is not paid or tendered as aforesaid, the lease shall terminate as to both parties, unless the lessee on or before that date shall pay or tender to the lessor or to the lessor's credit in the bank at Tulsa, Oklahoma, the sum of \$50.00, which shall constitute the consideration for the lease.

Should the first well drilled on the above described land be a dry hole, then, and in that event, if a second well is not commenced on said land within twelve months from the expiration of the last rental period which rental has been paid, this lease shall terminate as to both parties, unless the lessee on or before the expiration of said twelve months shall resume the payment of rentals in the same amount and in the same manner as hereinbefore provided. And it is agreed that upon the resumption of the payment of rentals, as above provided, that the last preceding paragraph hereof, governing the payment of rentals and the effect thereof, shall continue in force just as though there had been no interruption in the rental payments.

If said lessor owns a less interest in the above described land than the entire and undivided fee simple estate therein, then the royalties and rentals herein provided shall be paid the lessor only in proportion which his interest bears to the whole and undivided fee.

Lessee shall have the right to use, free of cost, gas, oil and water produced on said land for operation thereon, except water from wells of lessor.

When requested by the lessor, lessee shall bury his pipe lines below plow depth.

No well shall be drilled nearer than 200 feet to the house or barn now on the premises, without the written consent of the lessor.

Lessee shall pay for damages caused by his operations to growing crops on said lands.

Lessee shall have the right at any time to remove all machinery and fixtures placed on said premises, including the right to draw and remove casing. If the estate of either party hereto is assigned, and the privilege of assigning in whole or in part is expressly allowed, the covenants hereof shall extend to their heirs, executors, administrators, successors or assigns, but no change in the ownership of the land or assignment of rentals or royalties shall be binding on the lessee until after the lessee has been furnished with a written transfer or assignment or a true copy thereof; and it is hereby agreed in the event this lease shall be assigned as to a part or parts of the above described lands and the assignee or assignees of such part or parts shall fail or make default in the payment of the proportionate part of the rentals due from him, or them, such default shall not operate to defeat or affect this lease in so far as it covers a part or parts of said lands which the said lessee or any assignee thereof shall make due payment of said rental.

Lessor hereby warrants and agrees to defend the title to the lands herein described, and agrees that the lessee shall have the right at any time to redeem from lessor, by payment, any mortgage, taxes or other liens on the above described lands, in the event of default of payment by lessor, and be subrogated to the rights of the holder thereof.
