This Indenture made and executed this 24th
day of November 1906, by the Galbreath Colcord
Oil Company Witnesseth that whereas the
Honorable Secretary of the Interior on Nov-
ember 2-1906, granted authority to messrs
William D. Guthrie Weston Atwood and Robert
Galbreath lessees of a certain oil and
-gas mining lease, executed by Robert O.
Barber, dated April 22 1904, expiring April
21-1919, and covering the southeast
quarter of Section 22- Township 17, north
Range 12 east containing 160 acres in the
Creek nation of the Indian Territory to
transfer said lease to the Galbreath-Colcord
Oil Company, and

Whereas, the said lessees
have this day executed a formal assign-
ment of all their right, title and interest
in the said lease to the said Galbreath-
Colcord Oil Company, and it is desired
that the said Company formally accept
the said lease and the obligations thereunder.
