

Deed of Purchase

Sheweth all men by these presents  
That John L. Mitchell for and in consideration of the  
sum of seven hundred four dollars to me paid by  
James W. Whitman do hereby grant, sell, guarantee  
and release unto the said James W. Whitman and  
his heirs and assigns forever the following  
described real estate lying in the eighth Township,  
District of the Indian Territory, to wit:  
That part of Lot 2 in Block 12 in the town of Tucker,  
Black Nation, Indian Territory, according to the official  
plat and survey thereof, having a frontage of thirty seven  
and one half feet to the alley line in rear of said lot  
No. 2, having a uniform width of thirty seven and  
one half feet and adjoining E & W. S. in said Block  
number 12, this being a strip of ground having  
a frontage of thirty seven and one half feet and a  
width of one hundred forty feet with a uniform  
width of thirty seven and one half feet.

This deed being made to release the claim of a certain  
trustee dated September 13, 1906 and recorded  
September 17, 1906 in Book 3, at page 58 of the records  
of the eighth recording district of the Indian  
Territory by James W. Whitman conveying said real  
estate to John L. Mitchell to secure the payment of the  
certain note therein named, the same having been
