

Release of Mortgage.

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Now all more by these parties. I as J. Salter, Esq.
in consideration of the value received, do
hereby acknowledge full payment and complete
satisfaction of a certain mortgage given by S. Borochoff
and Clara Borochoff, husband and wife, to J. H. Ely
for two hundred and fifty (\$250) dollars, with interest
from date at the rate of eight per cent per annum
from date, said mortgage was dated the 6th day of
February 1907, and filed for record the 13th day of
March 1907, and recorded in Book Eight, page 146 in
the records kept at Tulsa, Western District, Indian
Territory, by the United States Deputy District Clerk,
in what was then known as the 25th recording
district, of the Western District, Indian Territory, now
County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma.
