

"Assignment Of Contract."

Know All Men By These Presents, That I, More Redmouth, a Creek Freedman of Haskell, Oklahoma, for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand (\$1000.00) dollars, to me in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby assign, sell, transfer, deliver and convey unto Mr. T. S. Karp, of Muskogee, Oklahoma, all my right, title and interest, in and to a certain contract and lien specifically retained in favor of More Redmouth and expressed in two deeds executed by said More Redmouth to D. R. Beatty, W. B. Kerwin and R. S. Rolan, dated August 9th 1907, and to D. R. Beatty, dated September 28 1907, in which he conveys the West half of the North West Quarter of Section Two (2) Township Seventeen (17) North and Range Twelve (12) East, containing Eighty (80) acres more or less, and being situated in Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

Hereby assigning, transferring and conveying all of the rights, powers, privileges and benefits which I may own, or to which I may be entitled in and to said land and appurtenances by reason and by virtue of the reservations in deeds aforesaid and warrant the title to the same.

To have and to hold said contract and all rights, titles, powers and benefits of whatsoever kind, incident thereto or appertaining unto the said Mr. T. S. Karp, his heirs and assigns forever, free, clear and discharged of and from all former contracts, grants, charges, taxes, judgments, mortgages and other liens and incumbrances of whatsoever nature.
