

Release of mortgage

 William J. Neet } Know all men by these Presents
 that I C. W. Smith for and in
 consideration of the sum of One
 dollar to me paid by William J. Neet do hereby
 grant, sell, quitclaim and release unto the
 said William J. Neet and unto his heirs and
 assigns forever the following described real
 estate lying in the City of Tulsa Tulsa County
 Oklahoma to wit: All of Lot seven in Block twenty
 in North Tulsa, except the north twelve feet of
 said lot, also that portion of Lot three in
 Block six, described as follows: Beginning
 at the north-west corner of said lot three;
 running thence south along the line of
 Boston Avenue thirteen feet, thence west a
 distance of thirty-one feet to the line dividing
 the Creek and Cherokee Nations thence west
 along said line to the place of beginning:
 This deed being made to release the lien of a
 certain deed of mortgage dated April 9th 1906
 and recorded in the office of the Clerk of the
 United States Court, at Claremore, formerly Indian
 Territory, on the 11th day of April 1906, said mort-
 gage running from said William J. Neet
 and Mary Neet his wife to said C. W. Smith
 and executed to secure the payment of one
 certain promissory note of even date therewith
 and therein named and in amount \$216, the
 same having been fully paid and which said
 deed of mortgage was filed in the office of
 the Clerk of the United States Court at Sapulpa
 in formerly the Indian Territory on the
 28th day of April 1906.
