

Assignment

For value received, S. L. W. Moor, Secretary to the Commission of the Land Office of the State of Oklahoma, hereby will assign, transfer, and convey unto the Union Trust Company, a corporation of Tulsa, Oklahoma, or its assigns, the mortgage made by heirs S. H. Hlland, and Maud E. Hlland, his wife, to the said Union Trust Company, and which said mortgage was subsequently assigned to me by the said Union Trust Company, and the inheritance thereby secured, and the profits conveyed, which mortgage was recorded with the Deputy Clerk of the United States Court and Ex Officio Recorder at Tulsa, Indian Territory, on the 19th day of July 1907, in Book 14, page 444, and covers:

A part of Lot one (1) in Block one hundred eighteen (118) more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the northeasterly corner of said Lot one (1) in Block one hundred eighteen (118), thence in an easterly direction along the southerly line of that tract a distance of forty (40) feet thence in a southerly direction parallel to the westerly line of Primaville Avenue to the southerly line of Lot one (1) thence in a westerly direction along the southerly line of Lot one (1) to the easterly line of alley thence northerly along the easterly line of alley to place of beginning. A part of Lot two (2) in Block one hundred eighteen (118), more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the northeasterly corner of Lot two (2), thence in an easterly direction along the northerly line of said Lot a distance of forty (40) feet thence in a southerly direction a distance of fifty (50) feet and nine (9) inches on a line parallel with the westerly line of said Lot and forty (40) feet distant therefrom, thence in a westerly direction a distance of forty (40) feet to the alley line on one
