

Deed of Release

Know All Men By These Presents:

That I, Loren Conaway for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar, to me paid by Fred Feyerherm and wife Mignonne M. Feyerherm do hereby grant, sell, quitclaim and release unto the said Fred Feyerherm and wife, Mignonne M. Feyerherm and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to wit: That portion of Lot Two (2) in Block One Hundred & Seventy Five (175), more particularly described as follows, beginning at a point on the North East lot line of said lot 2, 25 feet south east of the North East corner of said lot: running thence 50 feet along said lot line in a south easterly direction, thence 140 feet in a southwesterly direction and parallel to the southeast line of said lot 2 to an alley thence 50 feet along the south west line of said lot 2 in a northwesterly direction and parallel to said alley thence 140 feet in a northeasterly direction to place of beginning, the same being a tract of ground, fifty feet by one hundred and forty feet, fronting on Boulder Avenue. This deed being made to release the lien of a mortgage dated August 3rd 1905 and recorded August 7th 1905 in Book O at Page 114 of the records of the Tulsa Recording Station of Indian Territory by Fred Feyerherm and wife Mignonne M. Feyerherm conveying said real estate to Loren Conaway to secure payment of their certain notes therein named, the same having been fully paid.
