

Release of Deed

Know All Men By These Presents, That Owen E. Taft, Successor in Trust, (Harry Lee Taft, Trustee, being absent and unable to act), in a certain Trust Deed bearing date the 13th day of February, 1907, and recorded in the office of the Clerk of the United States Court and ex officio Recorder at Tulsa, Indian Territory, the 28th Recording District of Indian Territory, in record Book 2, page 4403, and Illinois Land Company, a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of Indian Territory, the holder and legal owner of the promissory notes described in and secured by said Trust Deed, in consideration of the full payment and satisfaction of said notes, which full payment and satisfaction are hereby acknowledged by said Illinois Land Company, do hereby remise, convey, release and quitclaim unto M. E. Keiffer all right, title, interest, claim or demand whatsoever acquired in, thru or by said Trust Deed to the premises therein described, to wit:

The West Half of the South East Quarter Section Twelve (12), Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Fourteen (14) East of the Indian Base and Meridian:
