

Assignment of Oil and Gas Mining Lease

Know All Men By These Presents:

I, Lat D. George B. Shornfelt of Muskogee, Oklahoma, in consideration of one dollar and other good and valuable considerations to me paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold, assigned, transferred and set over unto the Julia Oil and Gas Company, a corporation organized, existing and doing business under the laws in force in the Indian Territory, now Oklahoma, its successors and assigns, to its and their own proper use and benefit, all my right, title and interest in and to a certain indenture of commercial oil and gas mining lease bearing date of May 29, 1907, made and executed by Samuel W. Brown and Jennie Brown his wife, citizens of the Creek Nation, Indian Territory, now Oklahoma, to me the said George B. Shornfelt, to wit, to a certain commercial oil and gas mining lease on the following described tract of land to wit:

Southeast Quarter of Section 23, Township 18 North, Range 12 East. To have and to hold the same unto the said Julia Oil and Gas Company, its successors and assigns for and during all the rest, residue and remainder of the term of years mentioned in said indenture of lease, subject, nevertheless, to all the conditions, rules and regulations prescribed covering said lease and the conditions and provisions therein mentioned.
