

Release of Deed of Trust

Release.

Know all men by these Presents; that whereas on the 20th day of March 1905, a certain deed of trust was executed by C. O. Frye and wife to Clifton George, as Trustee for ^{John} Dermott for the sum of One Thousand ⁽¹⁰⁰⁰⁾ Dollars upon the following described real estate to wit: The north ^{or} south seventy (70) feet of Lot Three (3) in Block No. Twenty (20) Cherokee addition to the City of Tulsa Indian Territory which said mortgage is recorded in Book 7 on Page 505 in the office of the Deputy Clerk of the United States Court and Ex-officio Recorder at Claremore Indian Territory filed for record on the 27th day of March 1905; Whereas the note secured by the said deed of trust has been fully paid,

Now therefore Clifton George as Trustee and John Dermott, as Beneficiary in the above mentioned deed of trust do hereby release and forever quit claim to C. O. Frye all their right title and interest in and to the above mentioned property which may have been acquired by virtue of the above deed of trust
